### FAQ's

1. *Why should I be doing this?* A: Because this is one game that you will really feel good about even if you spend all of your time in the sand. See the enclosed brochure for more details.
2. *Who is running the operation?* A: In the past it was a joint effort of the Evergreen Chapter of the First Marine Division Association and the Richard C. Mangrum Squadron of the Marine Corps Aviation Association. Both are Non-Profit Veterans organizations that are registered with the State. This year we are being joined by additional local Marine Corps veterans groups.
3. *How much does the Semper Fi Fund get out of this?* A: All of it after the actual cost of the Greens Fees, Carts and Meals has been paid. There are no professional fund raisers involved at any level. We are all Marine veterans and these wounded Marines are our brothers and sisters.
4. *How about with the Fund itself?* A: The same basic answer. Of the money received 95% is distributed to the families and patients. The remaining 5% goes to salaries and office expenses. There are 15 employees and 60 volunteers (in 2007), mostly veterans and spouses who do this for the love of their fellow Marines. You could say...it's a 'Semper Fi' thing.
